



# Legacy Library

## I. WHAT IS THE LEGACY LIBRARY

PeopleCare Health Services has the privilege of walking with clients, their families and those who provide care through difficult and trying times. Driven by compassion, empathy and love, we are humbly invited into the lives of people at their most vulnerable. The Legacy Library seeks to honor our clients and their loved ones by preserving through a video interview some of the history, stories and personality of those clients we've been privileged to know.

## II. HOW THE LEGACY LIBRARY WORKS

### a. Legacy Interview

1. With the signed, HIPAA compliant permission of the Client and/or their Authorized Representative, PeopleCare will send a team member to a Client's home or place of care to facilitate and video record a conversation (approximately an hour in length)
2. This conversation will include questions that could encompass the individual's history, fondest memories, greatest lesson(s) they learned, etc..., as well as any additional questions provided by loved ones that they'd like to include

### b. Legacy Recording

1. PeopleCare will then edit the video recording and present a copy to the Client and/or Authorized Representative at no charge as a way to honor the Client's legacy
2. The Legacy Recording will be added to PeopleCare's digital Legacy Library that honors and preserves the Client's we've had the privilege to serve
3. With signed, HIPAA compliant permission, a much shorter (5-7 minutes), edited version of the Legacy Interview may be included on our Legacy tab on PeopleCare's website

## III. FAQs

- a. Is there a cost for this service?
  1. *No. This is a gift from PeopleCare Health as a reflection of our Core Value of Legacy*
- b. Can family members be present during the conversation and recording?
  1. *Yes, if the Client and/or Authorized Representative grant signed, HIPAA compliant permission AND every person who may be recorded (audio and/or visual) has a signed waiver on file with PeopleCare Health Services*
- c. Are we obligated to allow PeopleCare Health Services to put a shorter, edited version in the Legacy Library on their website?
  1. *Absolutely not. We do, however envision a day when there will be hundreds of video clips of our Clients that people can visit, hear their stories, learn from their life lessons and, if even for a brief moment, "meet" the Clients we've been privileged to know*
